- ✓ Dick will work with Dilli to do the water quality monitoring kit. Jennifer Sohns will help with water monitoring project. Ideal would be to have 5 kits to test in 5 cities.
- ✓ Conference calls: Everyone should have a project for 2015. (If projects are vague Subijoy and Dick will follow up to make definitive. .) Then conference calls will be held to check in and track progress. Proposed calls:
 - ✓ Jan 19, 2015, 12 Noon to 1:00 PM
 - ✓ April 24, 2015, 12 Noon to 1:00 PM;
 - ✓ Future calls for 2015 will be set on Jan 19th.
- ✓ Subijoy & Dilli: To plan a trip to SW VA to see tributaries of Clinch River and through Bill Roper partner ROW with Community College part of the UVA system to monitor the existing condition of the River and compare later.
